St. Bernadette Community Clinic

Established in 1995 in collaboration with the Diocese of Lafayette, St. Bernadette's provides free non-emergency medical and dental care to the poor and those experiencing homelessness.



Congregational Health Services

Partnering with 25+ local church congregations, we support health outreach and strengthen community care. Offering vital resources to congregations across Acadiana such as blood pressure screenings, early detection for diabetes, nutritional education and more.



Northside High School Health Clinic

Acadiana's first school-based health center has served students and faculty since 1996. One Tiny Miracle at a Time Gigi's NICU Journey

Bringing a child into the world is filled with joy, excitement and anticipation. For Andrena Cluse, her journey through all maternity took an unexpected turn when complications arose during pregnancy.

Her daughter, Gianna "Gigi," was born at 23 weeks gestation – 16 weeks and four days ahead of schedule. Gigi was born prematurely with severely underdeveloped organs that needed time to mature. She spent 154 days in our NICU at Our Lady of Lourdes Women's & Children's Hospital. Thanks to the response of the team at Acadiana's only Level III Surgical NICU, Gigi's life was saved as she was able to overcome critical challenges.

Andrena said that during the five months Gigi was in the NICU, she was continually astonished at the care provided by people whom she describes as "angels" who put her baby's needs first every day.

Gianna has a personality full of life that can bring a smile to anyone's face.

"It was like God had sent every person who needed to be there," she said. "Gigi got the best care possible. There was not one thing I needed to worry about. I didn't have to ask what was going on or why things were happening. Every doctor and nurse was right there to provide me with updates. They loved on my baby like she was their own. When I saw how strong they were to take care of those tiny babies, I knew that as Gigi's mom, I could show up and be next to her."

Despite the unexpected twists and turns, Andrena is grateful for Gigi's life as an active 3-yearold and the bright future that lies ahead. Their NICU experience, including its challenges, became a chapter in their lives showcasing the power of hope, love and the unwavering dedication of our NICU team.

Ronald McDonald Family Room

Operated by the Ronald McDonald House Charities of South Louisiana through a partnership with Our Lady of Lourdes Foundation and Our Lady of Lourdes Women's & Children's Hospital, the Ronald McDonald Family Room offers a quiet place for parents and caregivers to get away while remaining close to their child and care team.

Since opening in 2022, all three rooms have been occupied by NICU and PICU families every week of the year.
